## CITY OF TORONTO

### BY-LAW 396-2025

#### To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, respecting Hannaford Street.

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, is amended as follows:
  - A. By deleting from Schedule II (Designated On-Street Parking for Permit Holders), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

| (From Column 1 Highway) | (From Column 2 Side) | (From Column 3 Between)                                                         | (From Column 4 Time or Days) |
|-------------------------|----------------------|---------------------------------------------------------------------------------|------------------------------|
| Hannaford Street        | East                 | A point 19.5 metres north of Kingston Road and a point 5.5 metres further north | Anytime                      |
| Hannaford Street        | East                 | A point 51 metres south of Lyall Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further south    | Anytime                      |

- B. By inserting in Schedule II (Designated On-Street Parking for Permit Holders), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

| (In Column 1 Highway) | (In Column 2 Side) | (In Column 3 Between)                                                           | (In Column 4 Time or Days) |
|-----------------------|--------------------|---------------------------------------------------------------------------------|----------------------------|
| Hannaford Street      | West               | A point 33.5 metres north of Kingston Road and a point 5.5 metres further north | Anytime                    |
| Hannaford Street      | West               | A point 44 metres south of Lyall Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further south    | Anytime                    |
